H&S POLICY STATEMENT

Stockton Heath Lawn Tennis Club's Management Committee regards the promotion of Health and Safety measures as a mutual objective for management, employees and members at all levels.

It is therefore the Committee's Policy to do all that is reasonable to prevent personal injury and damage to property and to protect everyone from foreseeable hazards, including the public, in so far as they come into contact with the Club, its operations and buildings. In particular, this Committee has a responsibility:

- to provide and maintain safe and healthy working conditions taking account of any statutory requirements.
- to provide training and instruction to enable employees to perform their work safely and efficiently.
- to make available all necessary safety devices and protective equipment and to supervise their use.
- to maintain a constant and continuing interest in health and safety matters applicable to the Club's activities, in particular, by consulting and involving employees and members wherever possible.

All employees and members have a duty to co-operate in the operation of this policy:

- by working and participating in the club's activities safely and efficiently.
- by using the protective equipment provided and by meeting statutory obligations.
- by reporting incidents that have led or may lead to injury to people or damage to property or equipment.
- by adhering to the Procedures for securing a safe workplace.
- by assisting in the investigation of accidents with the objective of introducing new measures to prevent a recurrence.
